




How do you know what to look for


15 Questions to ask your builder

Experience and Reputation

- 1. How many years have you been in operation for?
- 2. Do you offer finance options? If yes, are they an award-winning and reputable company?
- 3. How do your customers feel about their building journey? Can I see any current reviews?


Your home building journey

- 4. Does the builder do a shire and developer compliance check up before they go to site? These checks should be done up-front to avoid further costs down the track.
- 5. Do you have fixed site works? These could put your budget at risk if a builder underestimates the cost of siteworks. Fixed cost for siteworks means there are no surprises.



15 Questions to ask your builder

- 6. I'm in love with the finishes in this display home. Do these come standard? Sometimes builders will spec up their display homes and make you upgrade for them in your new home.
- 7. I really like my home design but want to make a small change to the floorplan. Will you let me know upfront if that will cost extra?
- 8. What is Prestart, and how much should I budget for this? How much does the average homebuyer spend so I can budget for my Colour Selection Meeting.
- 9. How long is the average preconstruction and construction stage? How does this compare to other builders? It's worth checking if there's anything they can do to reduce the presconstruction timeframe.

- 10. Do you use reputable brands? Are they designed to withstand the Australian climate?
- 11. Are you in control of your supply chain?
- 12. What is your relationship like with your trades? A good relationship means there could be less delays during construction.
- 13. What are your warranties and after care services like? Understanding what a builders after care service is like will help you know what service you will get after your new home is complete.
- 14. What is BAL? Do I need to consider this in the cost of my home?
- 15. Will a mortgage broker help me find the best home loan? Can you suggest any reputable mortgage brokers?
